**Local Response Team**

LRT. A squad for NEF is currently being recruited, a portable signwasher has been purchased and Transportation will be providing training on road side safety for instructors and trainees. The team is likely to be in a position to start cleaning road signs in the ward over the summer. I have been asked to contact you to get a list of the worst signage as a starting point for the crew. It would appear that Transportation have no database which provides details of the number and location of signposts so as part of this exercise the LRT will number and provide a map reference for each sign and will create a database. This will enable them to inspect signs and report back to Transportation on issues such as rusting, broken signs etc. There will be some criteria which will need to be followed for safety reasons as the LRT will not be able to close roads ie no major highways, signage on pathways on A roads

#### CALLS TO THE POLICE

In the past **72 hours**, Police in Fife have received **1,032 calls**.

**49** of the calls attended were **domestic incidents**.

We have responded to **96 Road Traffic Matters**. **42** of the calls attended related to **Road Traffic Collisions** - **#OperationParamount**

#### CRIME and VULNERABILITY

In the past 72 hours, there was **26** Missing Person Enquiries raised.

There have been **32 Assault** charges recorded on our systems. **5** of these incidents involved the use of a weapon and **8 resulted in injury**. So far, enquiries have led to **24 detected charges** against offenders. **#OperationPath**

There have been **16 Theft by Shopliftings** recorded in this 72 hour period with over **£400** worth of goods **stolen**. So far, enquiries have led to **11 detected charges** and the recovery of **£130** worth of goods. **#OperationPrinciple**

In the past 72 hours, **165 entries** were added to the **Vulnerable Person Database**.
