- 1. Matters arising from last CC minutes
- 2. Environment matters
  - a. Waste ground next to Old Bridge Council unable to take legal action on this. Chair & Vice-Chair met with DE who agreed to consider granting access if not tidied by 1 August.
  - b. Clayton Caravan Park Investigated a number of environmental issues raised by a resident
- 3. Planning matters
  - a. 17/00672/FULL Neiview Innerbridge St Rejected by NEPC
  - b. General planning matters had arranged meeting with FC officer to discuss but this was cancelled at the last minute and needs to be rescheduled
- 4. Police matters

- 5. Roads & Traffic matters
  - a. Loose railings on Motray Road Bridge FC Engineers have inspected and a contractor has been approached to mke good. Date of works TBC.
  - Speed limits on Pusk Road, Tool Road, and Station Road Traffic Management copy of proposed TRO/17/31 for comments.
  - Your speed sign Cupar Road A91 Guard bridge last update on this requested 5 June.
  - d. Water running down road from Seggie Farm. FC investigating in April update requested 5 June.
  - e. Cycle lane Old St Andrew's Road query about unmarked section of cycle lane. update requested 5 June.
  - f. **Street signs** name plates were requested for Old St, Cupar Road, Main Street. Last update hoped to deliver these 'in the autumn'
