## North Fife Cycling Club

A meeting of interested parties took place on the 16<sup>th</sup> January in the Burgh Chambers Tayport. Background In 2017 a group of local cyclists and supporters under the name 'North Fife Cycling Development Group' met to look at ways of 'supporting and developing all forms of cycling'. This group carried out a survey (360+ replies), and Kirsteen Torrance organised childrens cycling taster sessions at Newport School in the autumn. At a public meeting on 6th November a number of people were keen to set up a cycling club locally and Kirsteen organised this initial meeting of interested people with herself and Martin Harris offering to help set up a club through Scottish Cycling. This meeting was widely advertised through local contacts, parents of children attending the taster session etc. The previous North Fife group discussions and some emails had suggested that if enough people were interested in setting up a club that might run then alongside any other local cycling interests (that might focus on other topics like commuter cycling & infra structure campaigning with some networking links between groups).
